ROUTE INFORMATION - SNOWDONIA CHARITY TREK

Saturday, 27th July 2024

Itinerary & Route Information

Your group for the event will be guided by a senior KRDF guide with experience of trekking to Mount Snowdonia, so you do not have to navigate your way from the event base to the top of the mountain and back, your guide will do this for you. However, if you would like to read more about the route please refer to the information below.

Ascent - approximately 3 – 4 hours

Coaches will leave from London on 27th July 2024 at 2am or 4:00 am (to be confirmed) in the morning. On your arrival at the departure site, you will be introduced to your guide and the rest of your group so that you can get acquainted before you start. You should finish by 14:00, but this will very much depend on your walking speed, weather conditions and start time. Booking accommodation is your choice and your own responsibility. Walking with your guide you cross the car park and walk up the ramp onto the main road opposite the Snowdon Railway station, unfortunately it will be closed! Turning left you will follow the main road for 400m, passing the Royal Victoria Hotel, before turning right crossing the road and going through the gate. Continue to follow the path as it climbs through the forest leading you out onto the hill past Pen Ceunant café where you will turn left and follow the tarmac road up the hill. After 500m you will see the start of the Llanberis path which is signposted 'Snowdon Path' and heads off in an easterly direction. Once on the Llanberis path, you will find it well defined; pass under the railway line at GR595577 and again at GR608560. Follow the path past a large cairn and a large vertical rock alongside the railway line to the summit. Your guide will check in with event base at summit of mountain and require a big cheer from your group.

Descent - approximately 2 – 3 hours

Along with the rest of your group, and your guide, you will safely descend the mountain by retracing your steps following the Llanberis track to the lower car park of the Royal Victoria Hotel. Once you cross the finish line at the event base please make sure you check in with staff so we know that you are back safe.
